

Maiden Grass – Yaku Jima

Miscanthus sinensis 'Yaku Jima'

Maiden Grass

An ornamental grass from Japan. It is a clump forming grass with green foliage. Blade width is approx. 3/8" and 40"-50" in height.

It prefers to be planted in full sun, in well drained, fertile soil. It is fairly tolerant to dry conditions and a wide range of soil types. Once established, it can be dug and divided in the spring.

Cut back to approx. 6" above the crown of the plant anytime before spring growth begins.
