Hemerocallis, Stella D Oro

Officially, the correct name is *Stella d'Oro*, meaning *Star of Gold*. These golden stars of the garden were some of the original hybrids which contributed to the popularity of the genus *Hemerocallis*. Stella de Oro daylily is valued as a compact plant and early bloomer, reaching a height of just 12" with a similar spread. This long blooming daylily flowers from May to late summer if deadheaded and watered regularly.

The fragrant flowers are golden and trumpet-shaped. The foliage is also attractive, forming a dense clump that can function as a groundcover. Planting Stella D'Oro for a massed effect will transform dry or hard to maintain areas in the garden with grassy foliage and twinkling yellow blooms throughout the summer months.
